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1. LOG HOME KIT PRICES - 3 TIPS

Log home kit prices for a variety of kits can easily be found online. Generally, to buy log home kits will be cheaper than to build a 'handcrafted' log home where the logs will be shaped one at a time using special hand tools. However, before you buy log home kits, be sure you understand three main ways you can control the log home kit prices and the final built cost. One of your goals should be to arrive at a budgeted amount that includes everything -- log home kit costs, the land and site work costs -- and to finish your project at or below that budgeted amount.



1. Log Home Kit Size - whether you're estimating your log home kit prices by number of rooms or by square foot, in general, larger log homes cost more to build. And remember, when you buy log home kits, a larger log home will also cost more to furnish, to heat and cool, to maintain and to clean. If property taxes are an issue, the amount to pay each year may be related to the completed size of your log home. If you want to reduce the cost, reducing the square footage of your log home is one of the main options you will have.

2. Log Home Kit Special Factors - to know in advance how much your log home will cost when you buy log home kits, you and your builder need to accurately estimate special conditions that your project has that will add to the final cost. For example, is your site difficult to access by tractor and trailer that will deliver your log home kit? Can a crane that will be used to erect your log home kit easily reach the site? Are utilities accessible to your property or will you need to dig a well, install a septic tank and bring electricity to your site from elsewhere?

These are examples of log home kit prices and special factors that can add labor and/or equipment costs. Work hard to define and accurately estimate any and all special situations that you'll encounter when you buy log home kits. You'll want to be building your new log home without any surprises.

3. Log Home Kit Design - the more complicated the design of your log home, the more it will cost to build. Cathedral ceilings are beautiful but more expensive to build. Dormers on roofs, lots of windows, hips and valleys and additional wall corners are examples of log home designs that cost more to build than a four-walled rectangular log home with a simple roof.

Building with a larger single-story log home kit will cost more than the same square footage built as a two-story log home. The reason is that 'building outward' or horizontally requires additional below-ground excavation as well as additional roof.

And the heating/cooling expense will be higher for a single-story log home than for a two-story structure of the same square footage.

As you go about deciding which log home kit prices and design you want, pay attention to the concepts described above if controlling costs when you buy log home kits is a concern. As you may know, it's not only about the kit and construction cost, it's also about maintenance cost year after year. Simpler designs for the roof will be less costly to build and to maintain.

Enjoy the process of creating the log home that is just what you want and at the price you expected. Making it happen can take a lot of effort, but it's your personal involvement and persistence that will help ensure that the finished project is a log home that you'll enjoy for many years to come.

2. LOG HOME BUILDING - CHOOSING YOUR LOGS

Dreaming of building a log home? One of the first considerations is whether you'll build with milled, hand-hewn, or scribed logs.

Milled Logs

In modern day, most log home builders and kit companies use the milled variety. Advantages to using this type are fast delivery per order, near precision in joinery, and reduced overall costs.



Trees that have been milled have passed through a machine making all logs uniform in shape and diameter. Shapes vary. Dependent on your local mill or log home company, a milled log could be square, rectangular, round, or 'D' shape.

Milled logs are generally shorter in length. They are therefore easier to work with (with just a few people) and easier to stack when building.

Logs can be milled from a wide variety of tree species - cedar and pine being two of the most common. They are sometimes kiln-dried to create ideal moisture contents.

Hand Hewn Logs for Building

A hand hewn or hand crafted log is precisely what the name implies. Hand hewn packages come with peeled and cut logs, made by hand by craftsmen of the trade. These logs are often more expensive, slower to delivery time, but are used to recreate a look and feel of a pioneer or vintage home.

There are as many ways to peel and prepare a log as there are craftsmen and manufacturers. Logs left mostly round, then stacked upon each other further require chinking. Chinking is the process of filling in the 'cracks' between logs - a time intensive process that requires regular upkeep over the years.

Scribed Logs - Authenticity in A Log Home Build

A final method of building this type of home is to use scribed logs. These logs are also hand crafted but do not require the chinking step in building. To 'scribe' a log is to take a scribe tool and trace the space where the two logs come in contact with each other once stacked. That center area is then removed from with a saw.

Hand hewn and scribed logs are delivered and used at a tree's natural height/length. They may take longer to deliver and are certainly more expensive. Positive aspects of these logs are that they build more authentic looking period homes.

Personal Favorites - The Logs We Build With

In our family home we chose 6 x 10 rectangular, milled logs.

We made decisions based on available time, money, and skill required to build the log home. We were also adamant that the logs we used were locally grown. We also only had a few months to get our house built and needed to stay within a strict budget.

Final Consideration of All Logs: Moisture Content

No matter what type of log you choose to build with you will want to consider the moisture content of the logs. This is a point not to be missed as it may save you thousands of dollars of repair and restoration over the life of your home.

Moisture content and shrinkage is a serious consideration. Green, uncured trees are often well over 19% moisture. Optimum moisture content is 15% - 18%. Treating logs before using in building projects usually involves a kiln-dry or air-dry.

If you have selected hand crafted or hewn logs, ensure you are being supplied with either air-dry or standing-dead materials. Typical reasons for standing-dead trees are fire or insects - neither of which adversely affect the final outcome of your log home. A good log supplier will ensure that the inner moisture content and the structural integrity of a log is construction grade.

Air-dried have been cut and allowed to dry out to 15-19% before being sold.

Even scribed logs will shrink and bare large gaps in your walls and around your windows and doors. Chinking will be your only option should this happen.

5. URBAN HOMESTEADING - WHAT IS IT?

Urban homesteading today is a new spin on an old idea. In 1862 President Abraham Lincoln signed into law the Homestead Act, which basically gave an opportunity to regular folks to stake out a claim on a piece of land, at least 160 acres. One of the criteria was that they were to improve the land, which would often mean building a home and working the land. The work done on the land typically gave the new land owner the ability to be self sufficient, in addition to providing products or services for market.



Over the course of 126 years, 1.6 million homesteads were granted. While urban homesteading today does not allow for the receipt of free land, it does follow the tenants of developing the land toward a less dependent life. There are still rural homesteaders that have the ability to develop, or already have developed a completely self sufficient lifestyle. They may or may not "live off the grid", but would have the ability to do so should something cause them to need to, such as the power going out during a storm and remaining off for several days.

While the ability to be completely self sufficient still tends to elude the urban dweller, due to the general inability to provide for their own water and sewer, there are many things the urban and suburban population can do for themselves that will both reduce their dependence on others as well as impact the world around them. These are the things that will be the focus of this blog. Saving the environment, although reducing our impact on the world may be a side effect, is not the goal here. The goal is live a debt free life which is less dependent on others. To return to some things of a simpler time, but mix them with some things of today, in an effort to ultimately give us more freedom and a better life.

Urban homesteading today will take us into the permaculture garden. It's about how to find a garden composter solution, how to grow fruit, how to grow vegetables, and how to grow herbs. What place keeping chickens has in a permaculture garden, what to do about rain water collection, and what long term food storage options, such as canning food, drying food, and freezing food, can be utilized once your raised vegetable garden is producing.

Urban homesteaders explore the use of solar power electricity and wind power electricity, what outdoor cooking equipment to use for different kinds of cooking, and what indoor cooking equipment can be used without electricity. The goal for the urban homesteader is to become as self sufficient as possible while still enjoying life in the city.

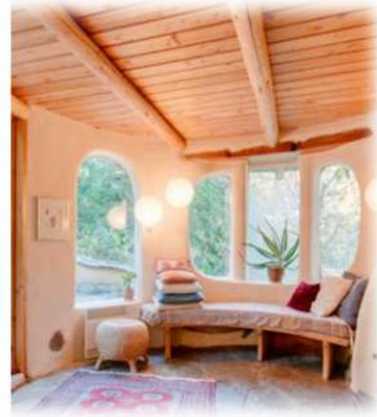
